

Today we're going to think about dreams and what they can mean to us

A man named Joseph was sold by his brothers into slavery in Egypt and he was imprisoned there. Joseph was imprisoned because he was wrongly accused of sexually abusing his mother's wife

Gen 39: 17-20

But Joseph behaved well in prison

Gen 39:21-23

Joseph's way out of prison and God's leading for him was to be through dreams

Gen 40: 1-11

Do you ever have dreams?

Do you remember them?

Do you think they mean anything?

Joseph was able to interpret the dream of the baker and the cup-bearer with God's help

Gen 40: 12-22

But the cup-bearer didn't remember Joseph until later

Gen 40:23

Later Pharaoh had a dream and the cup bearer remembered Joseph

Gen 41:1-8

No one could interpret Pharaoh's dream, but the cup-bearer remembered Joseph and he was sent for and interpreted the dream

Gen : 41: 9-32

Joseph advised Pharaoh to put someone in charge to rectify the problem which was going to arise and Pharaoh put Joseph in charge

Gen 41: 33-44

This was a great success everything happened as in Pharaoh's dream but Joseph stored up grain during the good years and this was enough to provide for the years of famine.

Gen 41: 47-49

In the end Joseph forgave his brothers for what they had done to him, because he saw that God had intended everything for good

Gen 50: 18-20
